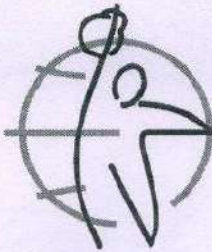


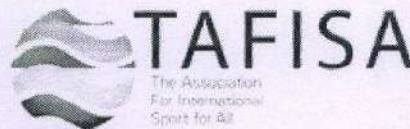

DISCIPLINARY COMMISSION

Decision of the Disciplinary Commission of the International Union of Kettlebell lifting
1. The IUKL Disciplinary Commission (IUKL) examined the case of a possible anti-doping rule violation by athlete Markov Ivan.

Athlete: Markov Ivan

Year of birth: 1995

Citizenship: Russian Federation

Sport Type: Weight Lifting

Sample N°: 4319983

Date of selection: October 12, 2018.

Sporting event: World Weightlifting Championship in Daugavpils (Latvia) October 10-15, 2018.

Athlete Markov Ivan took part in the World Kettlebell lifting Championship in Daugavpils. October 12, 2018 passed a sample of anti-doping control No. 4319983.

When analyzing a sample in a laboratory in Dresden accredited by WADA, a positive result was obtained (AAS / drostanolone metabolite 2 α -methyl-5 α -androstane-3 α -ol-17-one). The laboratory reported to ADAMS about the unfavorable result of the analysis on 01.10.2018.

IUKL (IUKL) notified Markov Ivan of a positive test on June 13, 2019.

In an explanatory note, Markov I. wrote that he did not know how the forbidden substance got into his body and claims that he did not use the forbidden substances.

On June 26, 2019, the Athlete requested an autopsy of the "B" sample.

After a request to the laboratory in Dresden, it turned out that this sample was disposed of in accordance with the International Standard for Laboratories (the shelf life of the samples is 3 months from the date of receipt of the sample in the laboratory).

Thus, IUKL cannot confirm the violation of anti-doping rules by Markov Ivan.

The IUKL Disciplinary Commission (IUKL), having examined the case file, decided:

1. To remove charges from Markov Ivan for violating anti-doping rules and to cancel the temporary suspension of the Athlete from participation in the competition.

2. Create a registered IUKL testing pool and enter Ivan Markov into this pool.
3. To plan for 2019-2020 a minimum of 3 sudden out-of-competition tests by Markov Ivan.

2. The IUKL Anti-Doping Commission examined the issue of a possible anti-doping rule violation by athlete Vladimir Kobzar.

Athlete: Kobzar Vladimir

Date of selection: October 12, 2018.

Sporting event: World Weightlifting Championship in Daugavpils (Latvia) October 10-15, 2018.

Athlete Kobzar Vladimir took part in the World Weightlifting Championship in Daugavpils.

On October 12, 2018, he passed the anti-doping control test No. 4319851. When analyzing sample "A" in a laboratory in Dresden, an atypical result was revealed (excess of the ratio of Testosterone to epitestosterone T / E. At a level of 4-6 with a norm of 4).


An additional analysis of sample "A" by isotope mass spectrometry (IRMS) methods showed the absence of prohibited substances in the sample.

At the preliminary hearings, the IUKL Disciplinary Commission (IUKL) issued a decision on the temporary suspension of the Athlete from competitive activities.

Having considered the case of a possible anti-doping rule violation by V. Kobzar, taking into account the decisions taken in this case, on January 21, 2019, April 5, 2019, the commission decides:

1. To cancel the decision on temporary suspension in respect of Kobzar V.
2. Introduce Kobzar V. into the IUKL registered pool and plan 3 non-competitive tests of the athlete during 2019-2020.
3. At IUKL competitions, conduct Athlete testing in a targeted manner. Use test results, including, to create a steroid profile of the athlete.
4. If an analysis of the athlete's steroid profile reveals a violation of the anti-doping rules, oblige the athlete Kobzar Vladimir to compensate IUKL for the costs of testing.
5. Issue a warning to Kobzar Vladimir on the inadmissibility of ignoring the decisions of the IUKL anti-doping commission on suspension.
